Decrease street noise  
Decrease water pollution  
Economic opportunities  
Fight soil erosion  
Habitat for wildlife/songbirds  
Harvest wood, mulch, lumber, or firewood

**What are the most popular Christmas trees?** *Fraser Fir, Douglas Fir, Balsam Fir, and Colorado Blue Spruce consistently rank the highest.*

**What can I do about deer?** *Avoid planting trees with soft needles, like cedars and firs, unless precautions are used to deter deer. (Netting, fencing, floodlights, certain odors, etc.)*
