*Authorizing participation by the Jefferson County Soil and Water Conservation District in the CAFO Enhanced Nutrient and Methane Management Program (CAFO ENMP) created pursuant to section 11-b of the New York State Soil and Water Conservation Districts Law.*

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Soil and Water Conservation Committee has issued a Request for Proposals inviting Soil and Water Conservation Districts or groups of Districts acting jointly to submit proposals for funding under the CAFO Enhanced Nutrient Methane Management Program (CAFO ENMP); and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available for projects that consist of activities that will reduce, abate, control, or prevent nonpoint source pollution originating from agricultural sources; and

**WHEREAS**, the **Jefferson** County Soil and Water Conservation District has determined that certain work, as described in its application and attachments for CAFO Enhanced Nutrient and Methane Management (CAFO ENMP), for the following AEM producers: #045-2005; ( the “Project”) is in the public interest and consists of activities that will reduce and/or prevent nonpoint source pollution from agricultural sources;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the **Jefferson** County Soil and Water Conservation District Board

1) That **Patrick M. Crast, Executive Director**, or such person’s successor in office, is the representative to act on behalf of the District’s governing body in all matters related to State Assistance under CAFO Enhanced Nutrient and Methane Management program. The representative is authorized to make application, execute the contract for State-Assistance, submit project documentation, and otherwise act for the District governing body in all matters related to the Project;

2) That the District agrees to fund its portion of the cost of the Project as provided in the application;

3) That one (1) certified copy of this Resolution be prepared and attached to the application for funding under CAFO Enhanced Nutrient and Methane Management program;

4) That this resolution takes effect immediately.
